# **LEBANESE CRISIS NEEDS**

## Introduction

Lebanon is currently enduring a profound and multifaceted crisis, compounded by the ongoing war waged by Israel. This war has inflicted catastrophic damage on the country, resulting in the deaths and injuries of thousands of civilians and the internal displacement of an estimated one million people. The severity of this situation cannot be overstated, as it adds another layer to the complex crises Lebanon has already been facing. Among the most vulnerable sectors is the healthcare system, which has been struggling under immense pressure for years and is now pushed to the brink as it suffers from the immediate and overwhelming needs of the war's victims.

## The Impact on the Health Sector

The health sector in Lebanon was already dealing with a range of systemic challenges even before the outbreak of the recent hostilities. These include the consequences of the financial collapse, widespread shortages of medical supplies and essential medications, and the significant migration of healthcare professionals, which has left many facilities under-resourced and understaffed. This has severely impacted the country's ability to provide adequate care for its population, particularly the most vulnerable groups such as those with chronic illnesses, the elderly, and displaced individuals.

With the escalation of the conflict, the healthcare system now faces the daunting task of addressing the urgent needs of war-related trauma patients, while simultaneously continuing to provide care for the chronically ill and those with ongoing medical needs. Hospitals and healthcare centers are overwhelmed by the influx of patients, many of whom are suffering from severe injuries that require immediate and advanced care. Additionally, the large number of displaced persons has increased the demand for healthcare services, putting even more strain on an already weakened system.

In this context, Lebanon's health sector urgently requires international support.

While many countries, international partners and humanitarian organizations have expressed their willingness to help, they need a clear understanding of the country's specific needs in order to provide targeted assistance. The attached annexes outline the most pressing medical supplies and medication shortages, as well as the equipment needed to effectively respond to this crisis.

## Call for International Support

The situation in Lebanon is urgent, and the health sector cannot survive this crisis without external assistance. While the commitment from international partners is appreciated, there is a pressing need for rapid mobilization of resources. The annexes provided offer a clear roadmap for how partners can contribute to alleviating immediate healthcare challenges. Prioritizing the delivery of medical supplies, medications, and equipment will not only save lives but also provide a lifeline to a healthcare system that is on the verge of collapse.

The Ministry of Public Health is ready to coordinate with international donors and partners to ensure that aid is delivered efficiently and reaches the areas where it is most needed. By working together, we can mitigate the impact of this war on Lebanon's most vulnerable

populations and help restore some semblance of stability to the health sector during this time of crisis.

Lebanon has faced adversity before, and with the support of the international community, it will once again overcome these challenges. The time to act is now, and we look forward to the continued solidarity of our global partners in this time of need.

## Procedure on managing Contributions in Kind (Donations) of pharmaceutical products, medical consumables and equipment's

### 1. Technical Specifications & Quality Control

The Ministry sets strict standards to ensure the safety and efficacy of all medical supplies entering the country:

- **Detailed List:** A comprehensive and detailed list of all medications, medical equipment and supplies must be provided to the Ministry **prior to shipment**.
- **Shelf Life/Expiry Date:** All medicines and medical supplies must have a remaining shelf life of **no less than 6 months** upon arrival.
- **Standardized Lists:** All donations must be strictly limited to the items included in the **attached official lists** provided by the Ministry.
- **Therapeutic Substitution Policy:** For Acute Medications, the Ministry of Public Health accepts molecules that serve the same clinical purpose or belong to the same therapeutic class as those listed in our priorities. Donors are encouraged to propose available alternatives if the primary requested molecule is out of stock, provided they are accompanied by clear clinical indications and dosage equivalencies.

### 2. Logistics & Documentation

To facilitate the entry and clearing process, the following administrative rules apply:

- **Customs Exemptions:** All donations meeting the above criteria will be **exempted from all customs duties** and related taxes (including VAT).

### 3. Centralized Aid Management

The Ministry of Public Health is the supreme regulatory authority for health-related aid in Lebanon:

- **Sole Authority:** The MOPH is the **only entity authorized** to manage, coordinate, and distribute medical aid within the Lebanese territory.

- **Redirection of Donors:** All hospitals and non-governmental organizations (NGOs) communicating with international donors are requested to refer them directly to the MOPH.

#### **4. Compliance and Refusal**

- **Pre-Shipment Approval:** Shipping should only commence after receiving formal confirmation from the Ministry based on the submitted lists.
- **Discrepancies:** Any shipment that does not comply with the 6-month expiry rule or is not addressed to the Ministry may face delays in clearance or rejection.

**Important Note: These measures are designed to ensure that aid is distributed transparently and reaches the areas of greatest national need through a unified government channel.**
